     April 23----- 9:30 am –1:00 pm.
- The course is sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation and the Citrus County Health Department.
- The class is hosted by the Early Learning Coalition of the Nature Coast. It will be held at their Meadowcrest offices in Crystal River.
